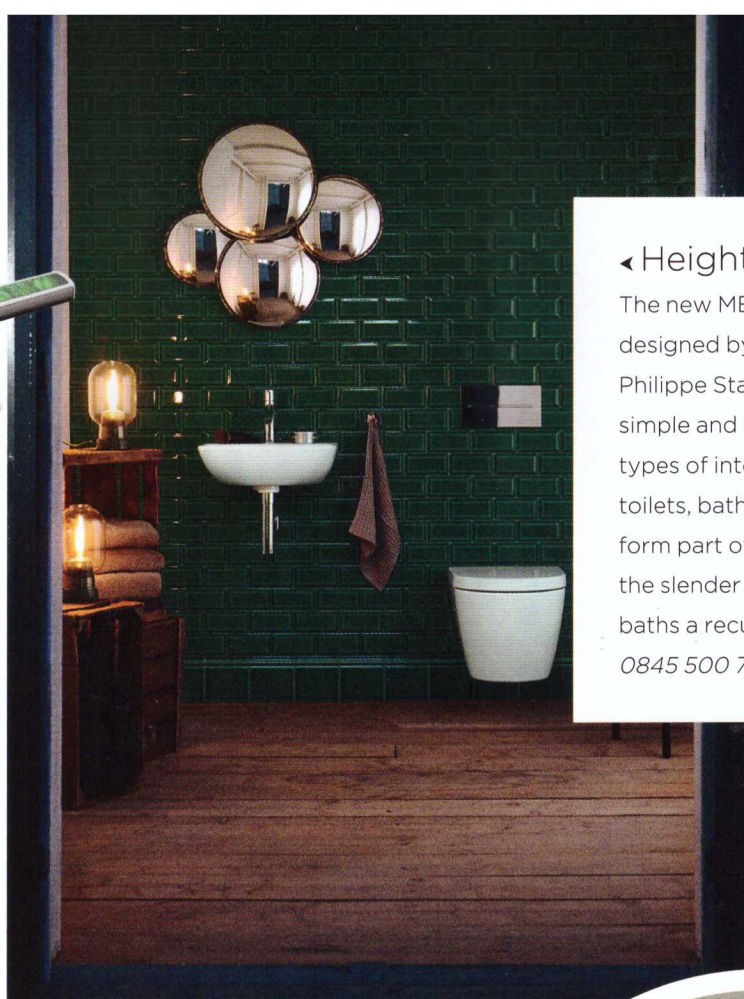


▲ Tap into glamour
